## ABOUT QUARTET VELA

Carla Obach, Débora Ñancupil, Marina Rosés and Laura Allès are the members of Quartet Vela. The quartet was formed in 2012 in the Conservatori Superior de Música del Liceu in Barcelona, where they studied. After continuing their studies in other European countries (Netherlands, Germany, France and Denmark), they moved to Aarhus (Denmark) in 2016 to make their music known.

Quartet Vela has received several masterclasses from known musicians such as Nobuya Sugawa, Jean-Yves Fourmeau, Otis Murphy and Arno Bornkamp. They have performed in many well-known venues in Spain and they won the renowned contest "Música als parcs 2017" in Barcelona.

In November of 2017 they won the 3rd prize of the P2 Kammermusikkonkurrence from the Danish Radio, the biggest chamber music competition in Denmark happening every 3 years.

During their time in Denmark, they have performed concerts in Musikhuset Aarhus, Musikkens Hus Alborg, DR hall, Rued Langgaard Festival, among others. Besides, their music has been appreciated in musikforenings halls and churches around Jylland.

In August 2018, they took part in a recording seminar at the Deutschland Funk and managed to acquire valuable experience in a professional recording environment.
